























Current Condition




Underflooring and joists rotted in sections inside


























Lansdale Freight Station Stairs








- 4' x 4' concrete landing pad 4" concrete


- New Step Stringers with solid step treads
 New step railings with 2" grab railing
- 28' new railing 4x4 posts bolted to deck framing 2x4 railing cross framing solid plywood facing
- Additional (2) 4x4 support posts to existing framing for additional support

Rehab, Next Steps


Repair and Replace

- Flooring: Remove concrete overlay
- Floor joists: Replace or repair
- Flooring: Restore or replace tongue and groove
- Transom windows (wood or aluminum framing)
- Freight doors: Salvage parts from rear doors to make front 3-4 operable
- Add ramps and permanent stairways front and back (ADA)
- Local contractors

Additions and Improvements

- Heating/Air conditioning
- Electrical Service
- Plumbing
- Restrooms
- Second-Floor Restoration


Possibilities


Potential Goals

Potential Uses
